



# Endives

Cichorium endivia L.

## Curled endive

### Wallonne/Despa



Very large and uniform, medium fine curled, self-bleaching, with full hearts. Good performance also under unfavourable weather conditions. For open field production in autumn as well as glasshouse productions.

## Broad-leaved endives

### Bubikopf 2/Perlita



Fast-growing, heavy, uniform variety with excellent self-bleaching ability. Wide, medium green, short, upright leaves surround the yellowish green heart. Suitable for year-round open field and glasshouse production.

### Diva



Grows upright, well-filled head, therefore very good self-bleaching. Robust against leaf spots, yellowing and rot. Sowing earlier than June can cause bolting. Larger than Bubikopf.
