



# Corn salad

Valerianella locusta (L.) Laterr.

## Baron



Baron is our quickest corn salad variety. It has broad-round, dark green leaves. Low soiling, high cutting efficiency and easier processing because of the upright growth.

## Granon



Particularly robust variety with high yields. The leaves are round and thick and have a wide leaf blade up to the beginning of the stem. Even if maturity is exceeded, the leaves stay in shape.

## Medaillon



Broad-round, glossy dark green, smooth leaves with a wide leaf blade up to the beginning of the stem. Compact growth. No tendency of leaves becoming spoon-shaped and long. Very suitable for open field and glasshouse cultivation.

## Elan

Growth is a little bit more rapid than Vit, especially suitable for cultivation under glass or foil.

## Vit



Leaves are veined, dark green and oval. Yield is higher than comparable varieties, therefore especially suitable for cultivation in glasshouses or cold frames in autumn and winter.

## Valentin

Dark green, short-stemmed corn salad with strong, broad-round leaves. Full-hearted, compact type, suitable for direct marketing and for specialised cultivation. Very recommendable for harvesting in sets in the open field.
