Seed for trial cultivation. Filed for registration.

HR: Bl: 1 – 28, Nr: 0.

Very vigorous, flat-formed lettuce with well closed base. The light-green, medium fine, curled leaves are very robust against breakage. No tendency to head formation, even in heat.

Senorita

HR: Bl: 1 – 26, 28.

Well-filled, heavy lettuce with excellent growing power. Year-round open formation of head, medium-rough curly leaves. The strong roots improve the resisting power and cultivation stability.
