



# Kohlrabi

Brassica oleracea L. convar. acephala (DC.) Alef. var. gongyolodes

## Noriko



Early, white, open field kohlrabi with many leaves, for early summer, summer and autumn cultivation. Large and tender bulb, tall stalk.

## Superschmelz

White, giant kohlrabi with a long development period. Stays tender even when 3 – 4 kg, planting distance: 50 x 60 cm.

## Azur-Star



Earliest blue forcing and open field variety, robust against bolting. Suitable for heated and cold cultivation under glass, especially for early open field productions. Slightly flat-round, deep blue, tender bulb with tall stalk.
