## Hybrid variety

### Igor, F<sub>1</sub>

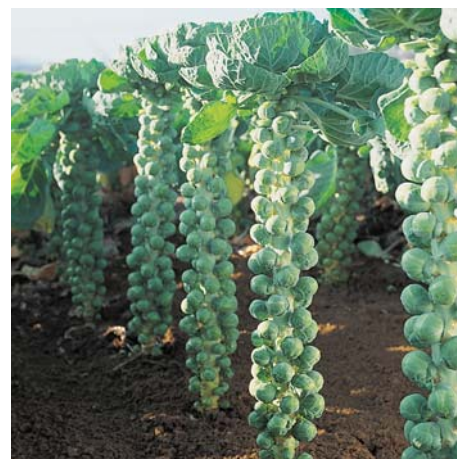


Medium late, high yielding variety. Vigorous growth, approx. 80 cm high, particularly stable. The sprouts are dark green, firm, smooth and of uniform quality from top to bottom. Very good robustness against frost, healthy. Suitable for hand picking as well as for machine picking.

## Open pollinated variety

### Hilds Ideal®

High yielding variety with long cultivation period. Robust against frost. Recommended for the resale of seedlings.
