



White cabbage

Brassica oleracea L. convar. capitata (L.) Alef. var. alba DC.

Premiere



Well-closed head, medium large, round to high round, short internal stalk. Robust against bolting, very early maturing. Recommended for the resale of seedlings.

Marner Lagerweiß

Storage variety, stays green, also after longer storage. Well-balanced head size, very easy to harvest and clean. Recommended for the resale of seedlings.

Filderkraut/Hilmar®

A real Swabian, pointed, very firm, late cut cabbage with excellent taste. Particularly suitable for sauerkraut production.

Very early, medium-sized, good quality for the market gardener. Recommended for the resale of seedlings.

Marner Lagerrot



The head is free-standing within the external leaves and is therefore easy to harvest and clean. Good shelf life in cold storage. Recommended for the resale of seedlings.
