

Round radish

Raphanus sativus L. var. sativus

Hybrid varieties

Annabel, F₁

Bright, light red radish for open field cultivation, especially suitable for cultivation in summer. Very uniform, stable foliage.

Isis, F₁

Very uniform round radish for summer cultivation with a shiny red colour. The healthy foliage remains compact and easy to bunch up, even at high temperatures.



Open pollinated varieties

Topsi



Fast growing, scarlet, round radish with fine root. Suitable for cultivation under glass, as well as for early open field production and protected cultivation under foil.

Raxe



Round, bright red radish for open field production with compact foliage, easy to bunch up. Raxe is robust against pithiness. Fine root base. For open field production from spring to autumn.



Patricia

Patricia



Semi-long, uniform, cylindrical, bright red radish with white tip. Excellent internal quality. Medium long, vigorous foliage, very easy to bunch up.

Icicle (HILD special breeding)

10–12 cm long, cone-shaped/pointed, white radish with short leaves, rapid growth. For open fields and productions under glass.
